- Perform Facials and Skin Care Procedures and Related Theory: structure and function of the skin, skin conditions and disorders, facial and body State recommend body procedures(client preparation, skin analysis and consultation).Wet and dry exfoliations and applications: Use of products to enhance skin appearance (seaweed, salt, paraffin, mud , ampoules, serums lotions and creams).Introduction training on advanced techniques such as aromatherapy micro current therapies, temporary methods of hair removal (manual tweezing, waxing, bleaching): Make-up application(color analysis, morphology of the face, product knowledge, chemistry and related composition, eyebrow contouring, corrections and contouring, false eyelashes, further training required for advanced techniques
